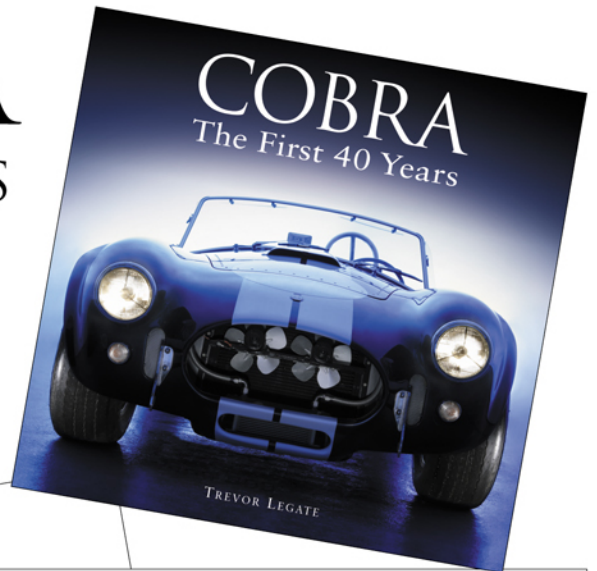


COBRA
