Infectious creative joy!

We don't need any previous knowledge, nor do we need a potter's wheel, when ceramist Frida Anthin Broberg exhorts us to give free rein to our creativity in her book *Fabulous ceramics*. With seductive pictures from her studio and home in the Swedish countryside, this is just as much a ceramics book with step-by-step instructions as it is a source of inspiration for all who love the romantic side of rural life.

The pages of this book overflow with the joy of creativity and it is impossible not to be enthused when old lace, flowers, twigs and leaves become lovely patterns on ceramic mugs and jugs. This is a step-by-step book about ceramics that shows you can use simple methods (sometimes even called 'cheating') to make your own personal objects. Thanks to the templates in the book, you don't need a potter's wheel either! All you need is a template, a piece of textile material, a rolling pin and a bit of plastic. You can go a long way with this when you have Frida by your side.

The book is richly illustrated with photos, some of which have been taken at the author's little country home. And forget all those ordinary, dull-looking ceramics books. Compared to this, they are just dreary instruction manuals. Here, light, warmth and colours flow freely. And here, too, the ceramist has a prominent part in the rural romantic style that permeates all the settings in the book. All these lovely pictures, the light settings and the author's bubbling creativity are simply infectious. This book will be the salvation of many a reader in the winter darkness.

Frida Anthin Broberg is a ceramist with a background including studies at the Gotland Art School and the Nyckelvik School in Stockholm. On a little farm in Rönne, Närke, in the middle of Sweden, she has her workshop and runs a shop and a summer café.
