Embroidery is one of Sweden's oldest traditions, while the embroideries have never been as modern as they are today. Karin's embroidery is an inspiring book with embroidery patterns for interiors as well as for clothes and accessories.

The projects are simple and suited to be used to make new buys more personal, to embroider clothes that you already have in your wardrobe or to brighten up a flea-market bargain. Karin Holmberg highlights many of Sweden's traditional embroidery stitches and uses them in new and exciting combinations. Finally, there is a section on technique with instructions about materials, tips and tricks and descriptions of the various stitches.
